**ORDER AFFIRMING NOTICE  
OF DISMISSAL**

On November 29, 2004, the Human Rights Bureau issued a Final Investigative Report and corresponding Notice of Dismissal and Notice of Right to Sue in the above-captioned matter. Charging Party, Maria Robinson (Robinson), filed objections with the Montana Human Rights Commission (Commission). The Commission considered the matter on January 21, 2005.

In the Final Investigative Report (FIR), the Human Rights Bureau Investigator determined a preponderance of the evidence did not support Robinson's assertion that Granny's Attic unlawfully discriminated because of national origin in the provision of its services.

After careful and due consideration, the Commission concludes the determination of the Human Rights Bureau is supported by the record and there was no abuse of discretion in the issuance of a Notice of Dismissal. *Admin. R. Mont.*

*24.9.1714(3).*

Charging Party will have 90 days after the receipt of this order to petition a district court in the district where the alleged violation occurred for the appropriate relief. *Mont.*

*Code Ann. § 49-2-509(5) (2003); Admin. R. Mont. 24.9.1714(5).* If Charging Party fails to commence a civil action within 90 days, the claim is time barred. *Id.*

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Charging Party's objection is overruled. The Commission adopts the determination of the Human Rights Bureau and the Notice of Dismissal is affirmed.
