ORDER

Jodie Goss (Goss) filed a complaint with the Department of Labor and Industry (Department) alleging the Browning Schools discriminated against her on the basis of her race, color and national origin and retaliated against her. Goss asserted she was not given an equal opportunity to teach summer school and she was prohibited from selling snacks when other teachers weren't. Following an informal investigation, the Department determined that a preponderance of the evidence did not support Goss's allegations of unlawful discrimination. The Department issued a Notice of Dismissal. Goss filed an objection with the Montana Human Rights Commission (Commission). The Commission considered the matter on March 17, 2009.

The Commission reviews a decision of the Department to dismiss a complaint using an abuse of discretion standard. *Section 49-2-511(2), MCA*. After careful consideration, the Commission concludes the determination of the Department to dismiss the complaint in this case is not an abuse of discretion.

If a charging party chooses to commence a civil action in district court, the charging party has 90 days after the date this order is issued to petition a district court, in the district where the alleged violation occurred, for the appropriate relief. *Section 49-*

2-511(3)(a), MCA. If a charging party fails to commence a civil action within 90 days, the claim is time barred. *Id.*

Alternatively, a party may ask a district court to review the decision of the Commission to affirm the dismissal of a complaint. *Section 49-2-511(3)(b), MCA; Mont. Code Ann. § 2-4-702.* This review must be requested within 30 days after the date this order is issued.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Jodie Goss's objections are **overruled**. The Commission affirms the determination of the Human Rights Bureau to dismiss the complaint against Browning Schools.
