ORDER OF DISMISSAL



TO: Shelley Smith, Charging Party; J. Ben Everett, Charging Party's Attorney; Special Logistics, Respondent; and Teri A. Walter, Respondent's Attorney.

On July 28, 2016, the Human Rights Bureau issued a notice of dismissal and notice of right to sue in this case. On August 10, 2016 the charging party filed an objection. The Commission was to consider the matter at the September, 2016 hearing. On August 26, 2016, attorneys for the Respondent submitted a Notice of Settlement. The reason for the motion was that the parties had reached a settlement agreement, pending finalization. Given the provisional nature of the settlement, the matter was re-scheduled for the November, 2016 hearing. This Commission issued an Order Vacating Hearing and Resetting in November. The parties were instructed to file a timely notice if a final settlement was reached prior to that time. On September 30, 2016, counsel for Charging Party and Respondent jointly submitted a Stipulation for Dismissal With Prejudice and advised the Commission that the parties had reached a final settlement agreement and that the Charging Party wished to withdraw her objection before the Human Rights Commission.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the objection of Shelley Smith is dismissed.
