The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 17, 1992, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Frenchtown School District No. 40, are as follows:

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Frenchtown Classified Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for the unit including Frenchtown School District employee(s) working as cook(s) and/or food service employee(s) who are scheduled to work more than two (2) hours per day, excluding cook(s) and/or food service employee(s) who are scheduled to work two (2) hours or less per day, excluding temporary cook(s) and/or food service employee(s) (employees who work less than 31 consecutive days), excluding managerial, supervisory and confidential employee(s) exempted by Section 39-31-103 MCA in 1991 and excluding all other employees not included in the above bargaining unit.
