The results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on June 18, 1996 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Missoula County Schools, are as follows:

- 45 - eligible voters
- 39 - valid votes cast
- 24 - Merged Missoula Classified Employees Organization
- 15 - No Representation
- 1 - challenged ballot

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Merged Missoula Classified Employees Organization as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all elementary hosts and co-hosts employed by the Missoula County Public Schools in accordance with the agreement for a consent election between the parties as signed and dated on May 1, 1996.
