22 On April 8, 2004 the above-cited petition for clarification of an existing unit was
23 received by this board and served on the Respondent on April 16, 2004. No response
24 was filed by the Respondent. On May 19, 2004 the Respondent indicated by telephone
25 that there was no objection to the inclusion of the two (2) employees employed as clerks
26 in the Laurel City Court as they shared the same community of interest with other
27 bargaining unit employees.

29 Pursuant to ARM 24.26.630(5) the relief requested by the Petitioner is granted
30 and the bargaining unit recognition is amended to include the two clerk positions. The
31 recommended order is subject to board review if appealed within 10 business days. If
32 not appealed, the recommended order is the final board order.
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
