Dear Mr. Hooks:

In compliance with the Public Employees Collective Bargaining Act, I conducted an election for Flathead County Sheriff's Department Employees September 26th, 1973 between the hours of 2:30 P.M. and 4:00 P.M., in accordance with the procedures the Board adopted.

The International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers, Local #448 petitioned for an election to represent such employees for purposes of collective bargaining.

The union met all the requirements required, and there were no petitions for any intervenors.

Twenty-two (22) employees were eligible to vote and 100% votes were cast, with the following results:

Nine (9) votes were cast in favor of Local #448 and thirteen (13) votes were cast against. A copy of the ballot used and results are enclosed.

Signed registration list and tally sheets are on file in our office, and copies are available upon request.

Also on file are ballots cast at the election.

The County Commissioners of Flathead County and Teamsters, Local #448 are to be commended for their assistance and cooperation.
