Dear Mr. Heikes:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 6, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of Eastern Montana College.

There were seventy-nine (79) employees eligible to vote of which sixty-three (63) valid ballots were cast. Sixty-one (61) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association, one (1) ballot was cast for No Representation and one (1) ballot was challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all non-exempt clerical employees of Eastern Montana College.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-SB60(7) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
