Dear Mr. Morrison:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 17, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes desired by employees of Helena School District #1.

There were fifty-nine (59) employees eligible to vote of which fifty-seven (57) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-nine (29) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO; twenty-eight (28) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes for the custodial and maintenance employees of Helena School District #1.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-S860(5) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
