Dear Mr. Thelan:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 3, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of Helena City Shops.

There were six (6) employees eligible to vote of which six (6) valid ballots were cast. Six (6) ballots were cast in favor of representation by International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, Local #231. There were no ballots cast for No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, Local #231 as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of the employees of Helena City Shops.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-8960(5) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
