Dear Mr. Woodahl:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 17, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of the Highway Patrol Bureau.

There were one hundred and seventy (170) employees eligible to vote of which one hundred and fifty-three (153) valid ballots were cast. One hundred and three (103) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; two (2) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Highway Patrolmen's Association; forty-four (44) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the International Union of Operating Engineers, AFL-CIO; and four (4) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all uniformed members of the Highway Patrol including Driver Examiners and excluding sergeants, lieutenants, captains and clerical employees.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals Provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-8860(7) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
