Dear Mr. Vukad:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 14, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of School District #3.

There were nine (9) employees eligible to vote of which nine (9) valid ballots were cast. Eight (8) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; and one (1) ballot was cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of the custodial employees of Hamilton School District #3.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-5860(7) Contracts(a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
