Dear Mr. Hokanson:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 9, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of School District #4.

There were thirty-three (33) employees eligible to vote of which twenty-five (25) valid ballots were cast. All twenty-five (25) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all non-exempt, non-academic employees of School District #4.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-S860(7) Contracts (a) one copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
