Dear Mr. De Money:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on June 4, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of the Montana College of Mineral Science and Technology.

There were forty-two employees eligible to vote of which twenty-six (26) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-four (24) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; and two (2) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of the non-academic employees, excluding food service employees, carpenters, painters and stationary engineers employed by the Montana College of Mineral Science and Technology.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-3860(7) Contracts (a)
One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
