Dear Mr. Groff:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on June 14, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of the Department of Revenue.

There were forty-two (42) employees eligible to vote of which thirty-four (34) valid ballots were cast. Thirty-one (31) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association and three (3) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all non-exempt employees of the Income Tax Division of the Department of Revenue.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-9860(7) Contracts(a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
