Dear Mayor Carrell:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 10, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Livingston.

There were twenty-two (22) employees eligible to vote of which seventeen (17) valid ballots were cast. Fifteen (15) ballots were cast in favor of representation by American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO; two (2) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO for collective bargaining purposes of the employees in the Street, Parking Meter, Cemetery, Garbage, Park, Water, Sewage and Sanitation Departments in the City of Livingston.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-S860(5) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
