Dear Mr. Pahnish:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 7, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for clerical employees of the Miles City Agricultural Experiment Station.

There were four (4) employees eligible to vote of which four (4) ballots were cast in favor of representation by American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO. There were no ballots cast for No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of the clerical employees of the Miles City Agricultural Experiment Station.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-8860(5) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
