Dear Mayor Micone:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on June 3, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Butte.

There were twenty-one (21) employees eligible to vote of which twenty valid ballots were cast. Nineteen (19) ballots were cast in favor of representation by Butte Teamsters Union, Local #2 and one (1) ballot was cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Butte Teamsters, Local #2 for collective bargaining purposes of the office clerk typists, clerks, deputy clerks, secretaries, meter maids and all other office clerical employees of the City of Butte.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-S860 (5) Contracts  
(a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
