Dear Mr. Robel:

The court ordered stay which prohibited the Board of Personnel Appeals from certifying the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative of Mountain View School personnel has been vacated (see enclosure).

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on August 30, 1974 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of the School.

There were twenty-eight (28) employees eligible to vote of which twenty-one (21) valid ballots were cast. Three (3) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO; twelve (12) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; six (6) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of the employees described in the Board of Personnel Appeals' Order of August 16, 1974 which defines the appropriate bargaining unit.
