Dear Mr. Stensland:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 29, 1974 for the purpose of determining the collective bargaining representative of employees of the Roosevelt County Road Department.

Twelve (12) employees were eligible to vote, of which twelve (12) valid ballots were cast. All twelve were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.

There being a clear majority, The Board of Personnel Appeals hereby certifies the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all non-exempt employees of the Roosevelt County Road Department.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"MAC 24-3.8(6)-S860(7) Contracts (a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
