Dear Mr. Watkins:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 14, 1975 for the purpose of determining the collective bargaining representative desired by employees of Libby School District #4.

There were thirty-eight (38) employees eligible to vote of which thirty-five (35) valid ballots were cast. Thirty-three (33) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO; one (1) ballot was cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; no ballots (0) were cast in favor or representation by the International Union of Operating Engineers, AFL-CIO; and, one (1) ballot was cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all non-exempt custodians, custodial aides, maintenance workers, bus drivers, and bus mechanics employed by Libby School District #4.
