Dear Dr. Anderson:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 20, 1974, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for employees of the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences.

There were one hundred and eighty-five (185) employees eligible to vote of which one hundred and thirty-six (136) valid ballots were cast. One hundred and twenty (120) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; twelve (12) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation; and four (4) ballots were challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE for collective bargaining purposes of all non-exempt employees of the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board of Personnel Appeals provide that:

"24-3.8(6)-5860(7) Contracts(a) One copy of each collective bargaining contract between a public employer and a labor organization shall be filed with the Board within thirty (30) days after the final execution thereof."
