Dear President McIntosh:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 14, 1975 for the purpose of determining the collective bargaining representative desired by employees of Montana State University.

There were five hundred eighteen (518) employees eligible to vote of which three hundred sixty three (363) valid ballots were cast. Two hundred forty-three (243) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association; thirteen (13) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO; Eighty (80) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation; and, twenty-seven (27) ballots were challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals does hereby certify the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all non-exempt classified employees of Montana State University excluding those presently within a bargaining unit represented by a bargaining agent.
