Dear Mr. Jensen:

The Boulder River School Federation of Teachers, hereby, petitions the Board of Personnel Appeals conduct an election for the teachers at the Boulder River School, Boulder, Montana. Enclosed please find 5 copies of this petition.

A brief discription of the unit discribed would be the teaching faculty at the Boulder River School. Teacher defined as one who has no hiring or firing duties. To our knowledge there are probably about 12 potential members, 7 of whom have signed authorization cards. The Federation is unaware of any areas of disagreement and is eager to negotiate a collective bargaining agreement within the framework of the law.

To our knowledge the Boulder River Federation of Teachers is the only labor organization claiming to represent the above mentioned employees.

At present there is no master contract, however, some teachers do sign individual work agreements when hired.

There are approximately 12 employees in the proposed unit.
