The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 1, 1975 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for policemen of the City of Lewistown, Police Department.

There were nine (9) employees eligible to vote of which seven (7) valid ballots were cast. Seven (7) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Public Employees Association and zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation. Two (2) ballots were challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies that Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for policemen of the City of Lewistown, Police Department.
