Dear Mr. Benjamin:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the elections conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on 13 January, 1976 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for teachers of the Pryor School System.

In the elementary school election (District #2) there were eight (8) employees eligible to vote of which five (5) valid ballots were cast. Five (5) ballots were cast in favor of REPRESENTATION by the Pryor Federation of Teachers, AFT, and zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of NO REPRESENTATION.

In the high school (District #3) election, there were seven (7) employees eligible to vote of which seven (7) valid ballots were cast. Six (6) ballots were cast in favor of REPRESENTATION by the Pryor Federation of Teachers, AFT, and one (1) ballot was cast in favor of NO REPRESENTATION.

There being a clear majority in each election, the Board hereby certifies the Pryor Federation of Teachers, AFT, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for teachers of Pryor School District #2 and #3.
