The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on September 15, 1976, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Pine Hills School, Miles City, Montana.

There were ninety-two (92) employees eligible to vote of which seventy-six (76) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-eight (28) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees and forty-eight (48) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies that there be no representation for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Pine Hills School, Miles City, Montana.
