The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 15, 1976, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of School District #7 and High School District #1 of Jefferson County, Boulder, Montana.

There were twenty-eight (28) employees eligible to vote of which twenty-seven (27) valid ballots were cast. Three (3) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Education Association and twenty-three (23) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Boulder Association of Teachers. Zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of No. Representation and one (1) ballot was challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the BOULDER ASSOCIATION OF TEACHERS as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of School District #7 and High School District #1, Jefferson County, Boulder, Montana.
