The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on November 14, 1977, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Butte-Silver Bow County Government.

There were sixty (60) employees eligible to vote of which forty-nine(49) valid ballots were cast. Forty-nine (49) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and no (0) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for the Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department, consisting of all uniformed and investigatory officers including the rank of Lieutenant and all dispatchers excluding the Chief Law Enforcement Officer, and immediate subordinate and Captains.

The appropriate Collective Bargaining Unit of the Butte-Silver Bow Law Enforcement Department is a unit consisting of all uniformed and investigatory officers including the rank of Lieutenant and all dispatchers excluding the Chief Law Enforcement Officer, and Immediate Subordinate and Captains.
