The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on November 4, 1977, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Gallatin County Road and Bridge Department excluding office, clerical and supervisors.

There were twenty-four (24) employees eligible to vote of which twenty-four (24) valid ballots were cast. Nineteen (19) ballots were cast in favor of representation by Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen & Helpers, Local #53 and five (5) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen & Helpers, Local #53 as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Gallatin County Road and Bridge Department, excluding office, clerical and supervisors.
