The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 16, 1977, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Silver Bow County School District #1, Butte, Montana.

There were eighty-four (84) employees eligible to vote of which forty-seven (47) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-seven (27) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Amalgamated Transit Union, four (4) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Construction and General Laborers Union, Local #1334, ten (10) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Butte Teamsters, Local #2 and six (6) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Amalgamated Transit Union as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Silver Bow County School District #1, Butte, Montana.
