The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 4, 1978 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Stillwater School District No. 5 (Park City, Montana).

There were nine (9) employees eligible to vote of which eight (8) valid ballots were cast. Six (6) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Park City Affiliated Staff #3778, Affiliated with the American Federation of Teachers, AFL-CIO, zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of no representation and two (2) ballots were challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Park City Affiliated Staff #3778, Affiliated with the American Federation of Teachers, AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Stillwater School District No. 5 (Park City, Montana).
