The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 26, 1978, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Shelby.

There were fourteen (14) employees eligible to vote of which ten (10) valid ballots were cast. Ten (10) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Chauffeurs, Teamsters, Warehousemen and Helpers, Local 45 and zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.
