The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 15, 1979, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Yellowstone County Metra.

There were three (3) employees eligible to vote of which three (3) valid ballots were cast. Two (2) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Chauffeurs, Teamsters, and Helpers Local Union #190, zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation, and one ballot was challenged.
