The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 4, 1979, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Employment and Training Division of the Department of Labor and Industry.

There were thirteen (13) employees eligible to vote of which thirteen (13) valid ballots were cast. Seven (7) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., and six (6) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.
