The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 25, 1979 to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Lewistown Police Department.

There were nine (9) employees eligible to vote of which eight (8) valid ballots were cast. Six (6) ballots were cast in favor of representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, no ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Lewistown Police Protective Association, and two (2) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Lewistown Police Department.
