The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 6, 1979, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Denton Public Schools, District No. 84.

There were fifteen (15) employees eligible to vote of which fifteen (15) valid ballots were cast. Nine (9) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Denton Federation of Teachers, MFT, AFT, AFL-CIO, and six (6) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Denton Federation of Teachers, MFT, AFT, AFL-CIO as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Denton Public Schools, District No. 84.
