The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on April 18, 1979, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Buildings and Grounds Bureau, Department of Administration.

There were seventeen (17) employees eligible to vote of which thirteen (13) valid ballots were cast. Nine (9) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by AFSCME Council #9, AFL-CIO, and four (4) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana State Council #9, American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Buildings & Grounds Bureau, Department of Administration.



As you know, there has been a turn of events recently regarding the Maintenance Workers and Security Guards in the General Services Division, Department of Administration. The employees circulated and obtained a substantial majority of signatures on a petition requesting that they be released from any agreement made between them and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Union, Council No. 9, AFL-CIO.

Recognizing that a clear majority of the employees do not wish to be represented by AFSCME, or apparently anyone else, please consider this letter formal notification by both AFSCME and the State of Montana of acceptance of the employees' request. Due to the acceptance of the employees' request, no negotiations will take place, and employees will become eligible for House Bill 891 pay and benefit increases for the biennium.

Please keep this letter on file with the petition sent to you earlier for reference purposes.
