Dear Mr. Poore:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the result of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 6, 1980, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Billings School District No. 2.

There were one-hundred forty-seven (147) employees eligible to vote, of which one-hundred thirty-seven (137) valid ballots were cast. Eighty-five (85) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., and fifty-two (52) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation. Two (2) Challenge Ballots and one (1) Void Ballot remains.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Billings School District No. 2.
