Dear Mr. Peoples:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 3, 1979, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Butte-Silver Bow Government.

Unit #1, the Butte-Silver Bow Courthouse, had seventy seven (77) employees eligible to vote, of which sixty nine (69) valid ballots were cast. Forty two (42) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association and twenty four (24) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Butte Teamsters Union Local #2. Three ballots were challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Unit #1, Butte-Silver Bow Courthouse.

Unit #2, Silver Bow General Hospital, had thirty four (34) employees eligible to vote, of which thirty (30) valid ballots were cast. Twenty six (26) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Butte Teamsters Union Local #2, and three (3) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association. One ballot was challenged.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Butte Teamsters Union Local #2 as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Unit #3, Silver Bow General Hospital.

Unit #3, Butte Public Library, had five (5) employees eligible to vote of which five (5) valid ballots were cast. Five (5) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association and zero (0) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Butte Teamsters Union Local #2.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Public Employees Association as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Unit #3, the Butte Public Library.
