Dear Mayor Roberts:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on September 24, 1980, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Hardin.

There were eighteen (18) employees eligible to vote of which fourteen (14) valid ballots were cast. Twelve (12) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Chauffeurs, Teamsters and Helpers, Local #190, and two (2) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Chauffeurs, Teamsters and Helpers, Local #190, Independent, affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the City of Hardin.
