The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on September 17, 1980, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Lockwood School District #26, Billings, Montana.

There were ten (10) employees eligible to vote, of which eight (8) valid ballots were cast. Five (5) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Chauffeurs, Teamsters, and Helpers Local Union #190 and three (3) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Chauffeurs, Teamsters, and Helpers, Local Union #190 as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Lockwood School District #26.
