The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on February 18, 1981, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Billings School District No. 2 - Food Service Employees.

There were one hundred forty-five (145) employees eligible to vote of which sixty-four (64) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-one (21) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Montana Public Employees Association, Inc. and forty-three (43) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies that there be no representation for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Billings School District No. 2 - Food Service Employees.
