Dear Mr. Johns:

The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on December 3 and 4, 1981, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Flathead County.

There were seventy-eight (78) employees eligible to vote of which seventy-three (73) valid ballots were cast. Nine (9) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Public Employees Association, Inc., and twenty (20) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Montana Council No. 9, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and forty-four ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies that there be No Representation for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Flathead County - clerical, building maintenance and miscellaneous employees.
