The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the mail ballot election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 30, 1981, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Gallatin County Sheriff's Office.

There were forty-six (46) employees eligible to vote of which forty-two (42) valid ballots were cast. Twenty-four (24) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and eighteen (18) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Gallatin County Sheriff's Office.
