The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on May 20, 1981, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Sheridan School District No. 5.

There were twenty-three (23) employees eligible to vote, of which twenty-one (21) valid ballots were cast. Eighteen (18) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Montana Federation of Teachers, AFT, AFL-CIO and three (3) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Montana Federation of Teachers, AFT, AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Sheridan School District No. 5.
