The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on October 22, 1982, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Yellowstone County Sheriff's Department.

There were twenty (20) employees eligible to vote of which seventeen (17) valid ballots were cast. Five (5) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by Teamsters Local No. 190 and twelve (12) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certified that there be No Representation for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Yellowstone County Sheriff's Department.
