The purpose of this letter is to certify the results of the election conducted by the Board of Personnel Appeals on June 3, 1982, to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Gallatin County Sheriffs Department.

There were fifty-six (56) employees eligible to vote of which fifty (50) valid ballots were cast. Thirty-three (33) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the Deputy Sheriffs Association of Gallatin County, thirteen (13) ballots were cast in favor of Representation by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and four (4) ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board hereby certifies the Deputy Sheriffs Association of Gallatin County as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Gallatin County Sheriffs Department.
