Dear Mr. Block:

On January 4, 1984, the Board of Personnel Appeals conducted an election to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of the Missoula Elementary School District #1 Hot Lunch Program.

There were seven employees eligible to vote of which seven valid ballots were cast. Five ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Teamsters Union Local #2 affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters. Two ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals hereby certifies the Teamsters Union Local #2 affiliated with the International Brotherhood of Teamsters as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for all employees employed as Kitchen Staff, Kitchen Help, Baker, Assistant Baker, Sanitation Lead and School Lunch Coordinator at Missoula Elementary School District #1, excluding supervisors and all other employees.
