On January 25, 1984, the Board of Personnel Appeals conducted an election to determine the representative for collective bargaining purposes for certain employees of Lolo School District #7.

There were fourteen employees eligible to vote of which thirteen valid ballots were cast. Thirteen ballots were cast in favor of representation by the Montana Education Association, affiliated with the National Education Association. Zero ballots were cast in favor of No Representation.

There being a clear majority, the Board of Personnel Appeals hereby certifies the Montana Education Association, affiliated with the National Education Association, as the exclusive representative for collective bargaining purposes for those employees classified as executive secretary, district secretary, secretary K-5, aide, nurse, maintenance person, custodian, food service director, cook I, cook II, and kitchen helper.
